- School to offer Metro spirit wear for purchase, maybe parents interested as well
- Funds for guitar repairs was approved in June
- Approved to use the library allocated funds to help pay for the Ukrainian/English books
- Halloween Dance for students will contact DJ for a quote and to check availability \$750 budgeted for this approved (KL, JV)
- Open House: Families will order meal combos from M&M Meats via Cash Online for \$7 (beef burger, chicken wiener, veggie burger + drink and bag of chips)
- Council decided against covering costs due to increasing no-shows over the past years which cost us money, as well as fundraising being limited due to COVID for the past two years
- Fundraiser: Delivery on November 10-11
- To run for 3 weeks
- Using Opt-in method or online boutique
- Permission/information form sent home and if signed and brought back to school, student can bring home a case (this option is for those who do not wish to pay up front, we will still do School Cash Online for this no cash, no returns). This form will act as a sort of "contract" so that families know they will have to pay for the product
- Add "number of cases" to form for those families who know they like/can sell multiple cases
- Students to pick up in office or wherever cases are being kept (storage room?)
- Keep opt-in forms on file, so that payment can be verified- If family wants another case, bring in another form
- Contactless (ship to buyer) allows us to offer the WFC variety \$3case (peanut/nut free) option as well as the WFC \$3 chocolate covered almonds (each case is \$90)
- 212 cases confirmed (200 + 12 free)
- To discuss funds to allocate for fundraiser prizing and what prizes to get at next meeting
- John (WFC) to deliver 5lb chocolate bar and 70 mini prizes
- Popcorn mini-fundraiser ok to go ahead, need a staff member to help coordinate distribution
